The **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** is a comprehensive reform of the EU's 1995 data protection regulation, being developed to strengthen and unify online privacy rights and data protection for individuals within the European Union (EU).

The new regulation comes into effect on the **25th May 2018** and will form a legal framework across all EU member states, resulting in a consistent set of data protection compliance obligations.
